

Eligibility: 1. Remain in attendance and active in your Church (participate in at least two of the Ministries of your Church) 2. If you will be attending a College or University out of the city, please remain in contact with your Pastor and Church on a regular basis. 3. Maintain an overall "C" or above average in your total courses per semester. 4. Submit a copy of your semester grades to the Scholarship Ministry by mail. Grades are due no later than two (2) weeks after each semester ends. This is to insure proper evaluation to continue eligibility for funding. 5. Must be enrolled in at least twelve (12) semester hours each semester.

Award: \$500 - \$1,000 **Deadline**: February 3
